The Academy of Music Performance (AMP)

GET AMP'D!

Firehouse is excited to bring our students a new way to learn music – by playing in a band! This all-ages program allows students to go beyond personal instruction by learning how to perform in a group setting. A public performance at Decatur's famous Eddie's Attic at the end of the semester allows participants to show off their stuff in one of the Atlanta area's premiere venues!

PROGRAM DETAILS

Applicants may select one of the standard 5 instruments: **guitar, bass, drums, keyboard,** and **vocals** or may select "other" for instruments such as horns or violin. Students will be grouped together based on their selection, age, and skill level.

SCHEDULE AND CURRICULUM

Participants will meet weekday evenings with rehearsals beginning the week of Tuesday September 7th. (Note that there will not be a Monday night rehearsal on Sept. 6th due to Labor Day – Monday night students will get a make up class later in the semester.) The final performance will be held at Eddie's Attic on Wednesday, November 10th.

The AMP curriculum will focus on playing as a group and performing live. A variety of topics will be explored. Below is a summary of the curriculum:

- **Week 1** - Introductory session with band members. Band name and song selection will be discussed in this critical first session.
- **Weeks 2-9** – Rehearsals and specialized instruction with other band members and band instructor. Topics covered include playing as a group, songwriting, soloing, how to "jam" in a given key and rhythm, and sound and audio terminology.
- **Week 10** – Final rehearsal and performance.

All Academy performances will be hosted at **Eddie's Attic**. Eddie's Attic is a Decatur music scene staple that has launched such acts as the Indigo Girls and John Mayer. There is normally a 6-month waiting list to play at their famous weekly Open Mic – AMP students get to bypass the wait and play there at the end of the semester!

EQUIPMENT & GEAR

In order to ensure progress it is required that all participants have the equipment needed to practice at home. Students that do not have their own gear may rent it from Firehouse.

FALL TUITION, 2010

- **AMP Alumni:** \$350 for the 10-week semester.
- **Current Firehouse Students:** \$375 for the 10-week semester. Note this rate only applies to students who take lessons *while also enrolled* in the AMP program. AMP students who take individual lessons are encouraged to practice their songs as part of their individual instruction.
- **Non-Students:** \$400 for the 10-week semester.

(Note that full tuition can be paid up front or can be broken into 2 split payments with the first payment due up front, and the second payment due at week 5.)

Please note there is a ticket charge for guests that attend the final performance at Eddie's Attic. This charge covers production and venue costs. Every AMP participant will receive 1 comp ticket for a guest or a discount on 1 reserved 4-person table.
